### MATHS

Look for 2D and 3D shapes at home. Can you name them? Try making patterns using 2D shapes or a junk model from 3D shapes. We will be learning how to double numbers and using addition, subtraction and doubles to solve problems. We will also be adding 10 more and 10 less to given numbers.

### I.C.T.

We will be teaching the children how to research using the internet. You could try searching some child-friendly websites to learn about the Great Fire of London.

### ENGLISH

Visit your local library to see if you can find out about the Great Fire of London. We will be learning to write a recount, sequencing events and using time connectives. You could try keeping a simple diary during half term to practice writing about the fun things that you do. Remember to use time connectives!
