School Meals – Working in Partnership with HC3S

Children who are well-nourished perform better at school. Scientists have shown that a good diet aids concentration, feeds the brain and helps build muscle for sports - and that's why we are so keen to encourage pupils at our school to take up school meals.

Meals are provided by Hampshire County Council Catering Services (HC3S), and their menus are specially designed to meet the government's nutritional

guidelines, which means that children who have lunch at school will be getting at least a third of their daily requirements.

At just £2 per meal, this represents terrific value for money and a real benefit for your child/children. It also saves you having to worry about preparing a packed lunch every morning.
